



Future Conservative Leader Scholarship

Guidelines

1. This is a merit-based scholarship awarded to outstanding female or male students exhibiting promise in future leadership on behalf of promoting constitutional conservative values of the Republican Party.
2. A scholarship will be awarded to 2023 high school graduates who reside in Walton County, and who have been accepted to continue their formal education at an institution or trade school of their choice.
3. The applicant must fill out the application form completely.
4. The applicant must submit a 500-word essay describing his/her personal thoughts and ideas on "How do you see yourself in the future working to uphold conservative constitutional values for which you have a passion?"
5. The applicant must provide an official high school transcript.
6. The applicant must include a Letter of Recommendation from a registered Walton County Republican who are not his/her parents and knows him/her well.
7. The applicant must have been accepted to a public or private college or university.
8. The deadline for applications is April 14, 2023, no later than 11:59 pm **and must be submitted to WRWFederated@gmail.com**
9. Applications will be reviewed and selected by the committee.
10. Scholarship awards will be deposited in students' name at College/University/Trade-Tech school of student's choice
11. Finalists will be contacted for phone interview prior to final award section.
12. **Deadline for Applications is April 14, 2023.** The recipient of the scholarship will be notified no later than April 28, 2023 , and award will be presented at the Club's May 3rd meeting.
13. **If selected, applicant must agree to allow WRWF to publish pictures and name of recipient.**
14. **This scholarship is for \$2000.00.**
