



Future Conservative Leader Scholarship

This is a \$2000.00 merit-based scholarship awarded to an outstanding female student exhibiting promise in future leadership on behalf of promoting constitutional conservative values of the Republican Party.

Guidelines

1. The scholarship will be awarded to a female student graduating in 2024 who resides in Walton County, and who has been accepted to continue her formal education at an institution or trade school of her choice.
2. The applicant must fill out the application form completely and submit with the following:
 - An official high school transcript.
 - A 500-word essay about the following topic, "Identify attributes of conservative constitutional values and explain how you would incorporate them in your future endeavors?"
 - A letter of recommendation from a registered Walton County Republican who is not her parents and knows her well.
 - Proof that the applicant has been accepted to a public or private college or university.
3. **Deadline for Applications is April 12, 2024**, no later than 11:59 pm, **and must be submitted to WRWFederated@gmail.com**
4. Applications will be reviewed and selected by the Scholarship Committee. The recipient of the scholarship will be notified by the end of April, and the award will be presented at the WRWF's May or June meeting.
5. Finalists may be contacted for a phone interview prior to the final award section.
6. Scholarship awards will be deposited in the student's name at a College/University/Trade-Tech school to which she has been accepted.
7. If selected, the applicant will allow WRWF to publish pictures and her name.
